If the swaddling cloth and manger remind us that Jesus was born to die, then the star, heavenly host, and Magi's gift of gold remind us Jesus was born to be risen from the tomb! Christmas and Easter are the high points of the Christian faith; incarnation and resurrection eternally bound together – glory hallelujah!

Throughout Lent this year, we've traveled with Jesus from the temptation in the desert to the home of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus and now this week, together, we travel with Jesus through his passion from the Upper Room to Calvary to the Empty Tomb. I pray you will join us this Thursday for Maundy-Thursday Service at 7:00 when we read together the account of Jesus' last supper, betrayal, trial, crucifixion, and death. Come agonize with him during his agony; feel the loss of the one abandoned; remember the one who died for us calling us to die with him.


